

Gateway to Gettysburg, One-Day & Multi-Day Tour

Visit the hallowed grounds where the Battle of Gettysburg was fought and other landmarks of the beautiful town of Gettysburg and scenic surrounding countryside.

One day tours include a driving tour of the battlefield with a licensed guide plus a visit to the Gettysburg National Military Park Visitors Center and Museum offering "A New Birth of Freedom" film narrated by Morgan Freeman and the restored Cyclorama which dramatically brings the battle to life in a 360-degree painting from 1884. The site also features hundreds of historic exhibits and artifacts. A tour is also included of the Eisenhower National Historic Site, the farm of President Dwight D. Eisenhower and his wife Mamie, which served the president as a weekend retreat and as a meeting place for world leaders including Nikita Khrushchev.



Multi-day tours may also include a ride on the Steam Into History train which travels on the railroad tracks that carried President Lincoln to Gettysburg to deliver the now famous Gettysburg address plus tour of the David Wills House where Lincoln slept the night before his speech. The Wills House today features five museum galleries and two recreated rooms, the David Wills Law Office and the Lincoln Bedroom. It illustrates President Lincoln's historic visit to the devastated town, the immortal words of the *Gettysburg Address* and the legacy of hope and healing that they brought, and continue to bring, to our nation.



Groups may also tour the Jenny Wade House, home to the only civilian killed during the Battle of Gettysburg, which still features the bullet holes from the fire that killed Jenny in the kitchen, and the Shriver House focusing on the civilian experience during and after one of the most historic battles ever fought on American soil.



Additionally ghost tours are available as well as spirits of a different kind at the Adams County Winery plus dining at the historic Dobbin House Tavern once part of the underground railroad and where James Getty can appear as Abraham Lincoln, and Hickory Bridge Farm for delicious family-style dining in a beautifully restored barn at the foot of the Appalachian Mountains decorated with hundreds of antiques. For shoppers, Gettysburg offers a downtown shopping area plus The Outlet Shoppes at Gettysburg.
