

Happy Holidays Gettysburg Style, One-Day & Multi-Day Tour

Visit the Eisenhower National Historic Site featuring the home and farm of President Dwight D. Eisenhower decorated for the season with Mamie Eisenhower's own holiday trimmings and a Civil War site also decorated in period style!

Located adjacent to the Gettysburg Battlefield, the Eisenhower Farm served the President as a weekend retreat and a meeting place for world leaders. With its peaceful setting and view of South Mountain, it was a much needed respite from Washington and a backdrop for efforts to reduce Cold War tensions. Enjoy this special seasonal look into the lives of the Eisenhowers outside the Oval Office.

Also visit the Shriver House where a guide in period attire as you walk through the Shriver's meticulously restored 1860 home to learn the other side of the story - the civilian side of the Battle of Gettysburg. Connect to the past while you listen to the story of George, Hettie, Sadie (7) and Mollie (5) unfold as you move from room to room to appreciate what life was like before, during, and after the Civil War with holiday décor from the period as well.

Lunch options include a served or buffet meal at the historic Dobbin House or Farnsworth House, or a family-style meal at Hickory Bridge Farm. Lunch can also be on own in downtown Gettysburg. Period reenactors such as President Lincoln may be available to visit group at one of the restaurants.

Additionally we can include time to browse among the quaint shops around Lincoln Circle in downtown Gettysburg or at the Outlets at Gettysburg, and perhaps visit a winery for more holiday spirit.
