

We Are! Penn State! One-Day & Multi-Day Tour

Learn what makes Penn State's University Park Campus in State College, PA such a great place to study, work and play. Each year the town welcomes 46,000 undergrads to study and many thousands more for Big Ten Football games and the area's fun sites.

A one-day tour usually includes guided driving tour through the campus perhaps including drive by the Nittany Lion Statue plus guided tour of the All-Sports Museum with view of Beaver Stadium if weather permits. This museum is dedicated to the athletic history and heritage of Penn State and includes galleries representing over 30 varsity sports with photos, memorabilia, artifacts and trophies. Groups will tour three pre-selected areas usually including the one dedicated to the university's legendary football program. A highlight of this section is the 1973 Heisman Trophy won by John Cappelletti.

Additionally groups may include time on own to explore the many downtown shops and restaurants including The Corner Room Restaurant popular with students and visitors alike or plan a meal at the landmark Nittany Lion Inn perhaps with a short performance by an acapella barbershop quarter from the Nittany Knights.

For another taste treat we'll visit Berkey Creamery featuring products made by the Department of Food Science in the College of Agricultural Sciences at the University. It is the largest creamery in the U.S. using around 4.5 million pounds of milk annually including some from the cow herd at the school. The site sells 750,000 hand-dipped cones a year offering over 100 ice cream flavors plus Penn State's famous grilled stick buns. FYI, Ben Cohen and Jerry Greenfield of Ben & Jerry's are 1978 alumni of the Penn State Creamery correspondence course in ice-cream making which teaches manufacturers production basics.

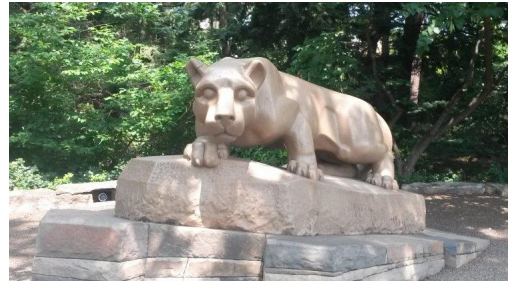
